September's full moon is also known as the Corn Moon, marking the time when the corn harvest typically begins. The imposing setting of Selene Wine Bar, overlooking Selene restaurant, is the perfect spot to celebrate the opening of the new season, as summer starts to draw back.

For the specific event, Master of Wine, Yiannis Karakasis selects a fascinating flight of gold-coloured Greek wines taking their colour either by skin contact & natural winemaking or prolonged oak ageing. This 5-wines flight includes dry wines from Crete and Santorini but also from Attica and Macedonia and features a unicorn sweet wine from partly noble rot-affected grapes.

Take a seat and indulge in this prestigious wine collection accompanied by a Greek cheese selection, while the surroundings and the art de la table reflect the beauty of the season. Live music by talented artists will of course set the tempo for a graceful evening, especially addressed to sworn wine lovers.
